Hi Jeff,

Well we have found in the Land Grants of New Hanover County the following info: David Hennesy - Oct. 20, 1767 - 200 acres on east side of Black River. (Moores Creek empties into the Black River a couple of miles from here.) James Hennesy - Oct. 25, 1799 - 150 acres on a branch of Moores Creek. Richard Hennesy - Apr. 26, 1768 - 100 acres on Widow Moores Creek.

And then I found a David Hennerya (I believe this is a misspelling or someone couldn't read the record and wrote down what it looked like) - Apr. 29, 1745 - 300 acres on the upper side of Widow Moores Creek, on the northeast side of Black River. Bk. 5, Pg. 363. Shuck no. 343

Are you aware that "shucks" were land grants that were entered but never actually issued to the person? If David lived around here in 1745 he may not have still been around at the time of our battle or he may have been too old to be in the militia. I am wondering if the 1767 David is the same man as the 1745 David? Do you know who his children were?

Peter H. Hennesy: On April 29, 1745, David Henessy (spelled Hennerya) received a 300-acre crown grant on the upper side of Widow Moore's Creek on the N.E. side of Black River in New Hanover. He was required to pay annually 4 shillings per 100 acres to the Crown and to clear and cultivate 3 acres per 100 within 3 years. This land grant may have marked the end of David's indenture.

Peter Hennesy: In 1754, John's brother David Hennesy was named by the province of North Carolina to be one of five commissioners of the Black River District (the triangle of land between Widow Moore's Creek and the Black River), "to make, mend and repair, all Roads, Bridges, Cuts, and Water-Courses, already laid out, ... in such manner as they judge most useful to the public." (Another one of the five was Allen Sloan whose daughter, Sarah, later married David Hennesy's son, Richard). One of their responsibilities was the maintenance of the bridge over Widow Moore's Creek.

Hi Jeffrey,

Sorry it has taken me a little while to get back to you, but we are trying to do some research into your questions. I have found a James and Sarah Hennesey who sold 300 acres of land on the east side of the Black River at Jumping Run (Jumping Run is not too far from here) to Thomas Corbett in 1766, and a William Hennesey owned land on the east side of Widow Moores Creek in 1813. So far we have found no record of a David Hennesey in this area. The dates say that he could have been James' son and Williams father. We also have not yet found anything about an iron mine. That is very interesting to us and we are continuing to try to find out about it. We are so close to sea level here that it is hard to imagine a mine in the area! I could not see your land survey. Can you try to resend it or tell me where you got it? Thanks and we will stay in touch.

Hello Tim,

We do know that John & Phebe (Moore) Soper's son, David Soper, married on Jan. 26, 1764, a Rachel Cook (born May 2, 1742, died March 27, 1807 and daughter of John & Rachel (Wilson) Cook. But we don't see an Anne/Anna marrying a Soper.

The Lenord of Hoose is Leonard (Jack's line)and he is of Hope Township, Durham County. Leonard and wife, Elizabeth, had 3 children: Peletiah; Leonard and Hannah. It was Hannah who received the 4th portion, Elizabeth, Peletiah and Leonard receiving the other 3. Leonard moved to Canada while Peletiah stayed in Manchester. Hannah married (1.) Jonas Butterfield, (2.) David Hennessy. She also went to Canada & had no children. Her husband David Hennessy fell through the ice and died. She died shortly after. There were no children.

We have seen the records regarding John Cook and believe, at this time, that he was connected only because he bought Soper property. [Of course we're always open to new ideas :-), if you find something we would love to hear about it]

Know you have David Hennesy in Duplin County at one point. I've found these to do with New Hanover County, also formed from Craven. Don't have dates or any other information for those things that don't have dates. Found all this at:

Imagine with David Hennesy we're looking at him being born sometime in the 1760s as he is in 1780s census data so much of this is earlier, but it does have a David Hennesy. A John Henesy's will of 1756 has him as having John, Jemmy and James Henesy nephews. His brother was a David. Sister was a Margaret.

Am increasingly interested in the Duplin/Sampson County areas as Strickland is a big name there (married into Simmons side of

family but are given as perhaps coming from Duplin County to N. GA early on, then going to MS/LA), and Crow and Corkern are also there. This Strickland married Cherokee in N. GA., but it's said that the Strickland families in Duplin/Sampson are all mixed Indian before then, some saying Lumbee (Cherokee variation). I don't know whether it's true, but Ethel had written me years ago and said Nancy Caroline Welch was part Indian. Welch was a Cherokee name in N. GA. This Strickland family also married Gills and Hennesys. So I'm wondering about all this.

He joined the rebellion, it seems because he appears in the North Carolina census of 1790 living in Dublin County, farther up the Black River.

"1790 Census shows Dan. INNES (Chatham Co. GA) and Andrew ENNIS (GA). One of these two could have been the father of Isaac Sr. Probably brother of David. 1850 census shows two Isaac HENNESSEYS about 15 to 20 years apart. The older one could have been the brother of the father of the younger one. Nancy was the name of the wife of the older Isaac. Marriage in Marion Co. MS. Shows David HENNESSY as father of Isaac HENNESSY who married Judith GILL(1820). MS Dept. of Archives and Hist. Finds no mention of David ENNIS, INNES or HENNESY in 1810 MS tax list or in 1820, 30, 40, 50 census indexes. Relatives believe that the name should have been HENNESSY.

Curtis Hennesy also writes, "As far as the name ENNIS, that came from the census records in Louisiana in 1840, 1850 and 1860. I would have to look up the records again but I believe our family went tby the name of ENNIS in 1840. In 1850, the same family used HENNESY, but in 1860 it went back to ENNIS. A story is told in the family that some of the local black folks referred to them as ENNIS. The same story teller said that this might have been a nick name. Since some of the ancestors could not read and write, the census taker would have to spell it in whatever way he thought it would be. As a result of this, I have found the names spelled: Hennessee, Hennessy, Hennessey, Hensley, Hensly, Ennessy etc. Makes life interesting. I am beginning to believe the correct spelling should be Hennessy. A letter written in 1925 by Ellen HENNESY BONDS remembers her parents said that it was spelled with one s or two."

Letter from Clarence C. Hennesy, dated July 25, 1939:

James Hennesy (grandfather) born January 2, 1840, died October 3, 1911, born in Tangipahoa Parish near the family graveyard, and died in Washington Parish, LA. His wife, Nancy C. (maiden name Welch) Hennesy, born February 9, 1848 and died November 6, 1925. I think also, born in Tangipahoa and died in Washington Parish. I have heard many times that James Hennesy's mother, wife of Isaac Hennesy, was from the Gill family, that Isaac H. and she migrated with some children from South Carolina, before the birth of grandfather James, and a story related to me just recently by Willie Cox of Amite LA., that when they migrated, (so his grandfather Louis Cox told him many times, Isaac H. and family left in ox wagon (evidently around year 1825) and left the Cox family S. Carolina, that one of the boys, (Louis) was courting one of daughters of the Hennesy family, and some day; or so after their departure, took a notion he would go also, and ran away and caught up with them, accompanied them to La., and married the daughter, sister of our grandfather, and became parents of George, Rufe and other Cox's not in Tangipahoa and others in La.

This story raises several questions: Isaac Hennesy and Judith Ann Gill were married in Marion Co. MS in 1820. The story says that Isaac and Judith migrated from SC in 1825?? Census records say that Isaac was born Abt. 1803 in GA. And that Judith Gill was born abt. 1800 in GA. It also says that the Hennesy girl that married Lewis Cox was the daughter of Isaac. Since Isaac was born about 1803 and Nancy was born in 1818, this raises the question of WHO migrated. It is unlikely that Nancy was the daughter of Isaac's brother Abraham because of his age. It is most likely that Isaac's father David did the migrating, since David had to sign for Isaac to be married in Marion Co. MS. In 1820.

Some relatives believe that Isaac Ennis was born in SC. Some Census show being born in MS and others in Georgia. Much of present day MS was ceded by SC to GA in 1787. Georgia ceded the land to MS in 1802. I believe that Isaac was born between 1785 and 1800. Present day Marion Co. MS was at one time part of SC and another time part of GA.

1860 shows a James McDavit, 19 years old, born in Scotland, living with Isaac, James and Judy.

Curtis Hennesy gives Isaac as dying 1861 at Tangipahoa Parish, LA, but it seems that he appears in the 1870 census with his wife Judith at household 265.

In April of 1862, the Confederate Congress passed an Act formally recognizing and legitimizing the Partisan Ranger organizations throughout the Confederacy. Captain James H. Wingfield, having distinguished himself at Shiloh, and wounded when attacking the Hornet's Nest with his Beaver Creek Rifles was promoted to Lt. Colonel by George W. Randolph, Confederate Secretary of War, and issued orders to return to Louisiana and raise a Battalion or Regiment of Rangers for immediate Service. The Beaver Creek Rifles were detached from the 4th Louisiana Infantry and became the nucleus of the new Louisiana Partisan Rangers as Company E in early May of 1862. The regiment was formally organized on May 13th, 1862 at Camp Moore, Louisiana as the 1st Louisiana Cavalry Regiment, Partisan Rangers. New troopers were recruited from Washington Parish (Companies A, C and K), Livingston Parish (Companies B & G), St. Helena Parish (Companies D, E, & H), East Baton Rouge Parish (Companies F & G). Company I (East Feliciana Parish) was originally raised under Governor Moore's authority and was attached to Wingfield's command when he arrived at Camp Moore. Company K was similarly organized, and filled out by the transfer of troopers from other Companies and with recruits of differing parishes. The newly organized and transferred Companies were leavened with veteran officers and non-coms transferred from other commands or by the re-enlistment of veterans whose original enlistments had expired. These veteran troopers were obtained from the 4th Louisiana Infantry, the 9th Louisiana Infantry, the 25th Louisiana Infantry and other confederate regiments. Though training was to begin at Camp Moore, the press of the military situation in Louisiana caused the Rangers to be immediately dispatched to duty. It was but two weeks until the first engagements with the Union Army was recorded.

2.0 acres of land bordering the Tchefuncte River for the amount of \$1.00. This land was to be used for a church as long as the church remained there. When the church was organized it was named New Bethany Landmark Missionary Baptist Church. At one time the church building consisted of only a platform. There are no records as to the construction of a church building.

On August 23, 1920, the Brooks Scanlon Company sold 2.0 of land to New Bethany for \$20.00. This is the land the present church is constructed on.

There is no record of the date of construction on this new site, but apparently a small wood frame building was built soon after the land purchase. The building, brown in color, was to the southwest of the present building and faced west toward Highway 450.

On April 7, 1924, the church voted to change the name of the church from New Bethany to Stoney Point Landmark Missionary Baptist Church.

In October 1939, the church voted to give Elder B. R. SMith, the pastor at that time, the authority to appoint a Building Committee. This next building was apparently constructed near the end of 1939, or early 1940. This was a wood frame building with white siding, located west of the present building and facing Highway 10.

On April 6, 1950, and again on July 6, 1961, Ila Hennesey donated 1/2 acre of land for a total of one acre to enlarge the church cemetary.

The Lord richly blessed as the church membership increased and the community prospered. The church members saw the need to construct a larger building. In the spring of 1958, the present building was constructed. This building was of red brickcrete, consisting of a porch, auditorium, five Sunday School rooms and two bathrooms.

On May 30, 1976, First State Bank donated 1/2 acre of land bordering the banks of the Tchefuncte River to the church, thus assuring the church of a place for Baptismal Services. This gave the church a total of 3 1/2 acres of land.

The building constructed in 1958 served our church communities' needs for many years. Some remodeling, including the addition of a large steeple, a large Sunday School room, a foyer and two additional bathrooms, was accomplished through the following years. Landscaping was improved over the years. The in 1986, a major remodeling project was begun. There was a need for more auditorium space, another Sunday School room and additional storage area. The building was reroofed, new bricks were layed, the auditorium received new carpeting and new pews. New Lighting and stained glass windows were among the new features of the building. Today you see the results of this remodeling project carried out and completed with God's blessings. We at Stoney Point are very grateful that the Lord has blessed us to construct a building for His honor and glory, a building that we can all be proud of for Christ's sake.

Yes, from its meager beginnings in 1910 up until this time, 1987, the Lord has richly blessed our church with 77 years of continued growth. He has blessed our church and community to grow and prosper. He has blessed us to be able to build materially and grow spiritually. He has continued to add saved souls to our church membership. He has blessed us with many good pastors as shepherds over the flock. But the greatest blessing of all is the many lost souls that have been saved during those 77 years; souls that may not have been saved if the Lord had not blessed us by placing His true church in our midst.

In Psalms 67:1 we read, "God be merciful unto us, and bless us; and cause His face to shine upon us." That is the prayer of the Stoney Point Landmark Missionary Baptist Church members today as we dedicate this building for His service and to His honor and glory.

We close these pages of history with this scripture from Ephesians 3:21, "Unto Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen."
