This account was found in Abstracts and Wills of Frederick Co., Va. 1742 to 1800. Record of above found in the "Filson Club" Library, Louisville, KY in 1973. Miss Ora Hooker told several years ago, that she believed that Adam's father, George Bower, was a brother to Henry Bower Sr. who lived in Pennsylvania, where his sons Andrew and Henry were born. We believe this "will", helps to prove she was right. All four of the first Bower families of Clark County, Ind., have descendants named Jacob, George, Henry, John A, or Andrew, Eve and "Kate". Above Jacob Bower who died in 1799, in Fredericks Co. Va., may have been buried there, at which time the others went on to North Carolina, Henry Sr. and George Bower, buried in North Carolina. Their sons, Adam and Joseph in the early 1800's, while Andrew, Henry Jr. and sister Kate, later in the 1815 year, all finally arrived in and near New Washington, Ind.

Bower Book: Henry Bower Sr. never came to Indiana according to Miss Ora Hooker's notes. He was believed to have been born in Sweden. Enlisted in the Revolutionary War while in Pennsylvania, Lehigh County. However, there were two Henry Bower men who both enrolled, one as a private, Seventh Class in Captain Christian Fisher's Seventh Company, Second Battalion, Northampton County Militia, 1778. This Henry Bower's residence ascribed Whitehall Township, PA (This could have been Henry Bower Sr.) The other Henry Bower, also began his service on the same date, May 14, 1778. Enrolled as a Private Second Class, Captain Peter Trexler's Fifth Company, Second Battalion, Northampton County Militia. His residence ascribed as Macungie Township, PA. Both townships must have been in Northampton County, PA. This information I received from the division of Archives and Manuscripts, Commonwealth of PA. The older Henry Bower in Captain Christian Fisher's Company could possibly have been our Henry Bower Sr. If so, he later went to Rowan County, NC, stayed there and lived to be eighty years old. His son Andrew Bower, born 1771 d 1840. Married a Margaret Thomas b 1781, from Orange County, NC. Some reports say Henry Jr. was born in Lehigh County, PA, but another report sayd he and his sister, Catherine or "Katy" Bower were both from Rowan County, NC. None gave her dates or place of birth.

BIOGRAPHY OF MAJ. DANIEL BOWER

Major Daniel Bower emigrated from North Carolina to Clark county with his father, and settled near New Washington, when there were but few settlers. He married Catherine Hostetler. Major Bower was a man of considerable influence and had the confidence of his fellow citizens. He served as member of the Legislature and also as county commissioner. He was the owner of several hundred acres of land; was a farmer and trader, often trading South with boats of produce. He died at Natchez, Mississippi in 1843. His widow still lives at the old homestead.

Baird's History of Clark Co., Ind. - 1909.

(Daniel W. Bower) having come to Indiana from South Carolina at a very early date and settled in Clark county, where he lived the remainder of his life. The elder Bower was interested in the manufacture of flat boats and he followed the old custom of piloting them down the river to New Orleans from which place, having effected a sale, he would back to Indiana overland. It was during one of these trips that he took sick at Natchez, Mississippi. Grandfather Bower was the father of eight children. They were: George, John A., Daniel, Adam, Elizabeth, Kittie, Anna and Eliza. All grew to maturity.

pg. 825: Colonel Daniel W. Bower served in the War of 1812. Colonel Daniel W. Bower was a native of North Carolina, who came to Indana and purchased one thousand acres of land when it was cheap, entering most of it from the government. He married Elizabeth Hostettler, who was a native of North Carolina.
