Benjamin Applegate was living in Burlington County, NJ in Feb 1752 when he made his will. Richard Sparks was listed as one of his executors, along with Walter Wall. Benjamins first wife was named Elizabeth, and there are those who feel she may have been a sister of Richard Sparks.

My 6gr grandfather Richard Sparks did in fact own 308 acres of land adjacent to Benjamin Applegate from 1770 until his death in 1792. His property was bordered by land owned by Samuel Applegate, James Wall,(322 acres), Benjamin Applegate,(397 1/4 acres), James Dean, Andrew Pearce, Daniel Applegate and Daniel Thompson.

JAMES SPARKS

A Revolutionary War Soldier buried in Jackson County, Indiana - Born: abt 1744 - near Brandberry, New Jersey - Died: May 25, 1834 - buried in Brown Cemetery or Sparks Cemetery

Soldier lived between the Youghiogheey & Monongahlea Rivers near Elizabethtown in Westmoreland County (the part that was later in Allegheny County), Pennsylvania at enlistment. about 1782 soldier moved from Penn. to Jefferson County, Kentucky and in 1800 he moved to Vincennes Indiana and in 1803 he returned to Jefferson County, Kentucky, then to Bullitt County Kentucky and in 1822 he moved to Jackson County, Indiana where he applied 15 november 1833 aged nearly 90 years, soldier died May 25, 1834.

In 1856 Mrs Ailcy NEWKIRK aged 79 a resident of Lawrence County, Indiana stated that she was 1 of the children of the deceased soldier James SPARKS and that soldier leaving no widow (no other children were named in claim), soldier's brother Colonel Richard SPARKS was deceased in 1833, in 1837 a Major Stephen SPARKS of Jackson County, Indiana was referred to and in 1856 a Richard SPARKS aged 46 and William H SPARKS aged 44 were of Jackson County, Indiana. No kinship given of these 3 men.

QUESTION FOR VIEWERS: Could William H Sparks, be the same person as HIRAM SPARKS? Hiram I was told is the son of James and I know the location of his stone but not his gravesite precisely in what is known as SPARKS Cemetery.

Hiram D. Sparks was the son of Stephen and Catherine Sparks. Born 1813 in The Indiana Territory and died 1849 at the age of 36. James Sparks sons Henry and Walter Sparks were in the Battle of New Orleans. They were in Col. Gray's Regiment and on Jan 8, 1815 the Americans whipped the British. Their brother Moses Sparks was in the war of 1812.

James Sparks was my Father's Great-Great-Great-grandfather. He served in The American Revolution 1777 . He served three years and four months. During these tours he had been "engaged in defending the frontier settlements...against the Indians and sometimes the British and Canadians who assisted the Indians." Stephen Sparks, son of James served in the war of 1812. He was well identified with Indiana, and records pertaining to have been found in six Indiana counties: Brown, Clark, Harrison, Jackson, Lawrence and Washington. He also joined a company of Indiana Mounted Rangers and continued in this service until his discharge on August 25, 1813. He also owned the Sparks Ferry of Jackson County, In. He was buried in Sparks Cemetery near Sparksville, In. (1775-1851) The town of Sparksville was named after him in 1857.

The exact whereabouts of the Richard Sparks family between 1758 in New Jersey and 1773, our first written reference to him in Pennsylvania is sort of a mystery. We do know that early in the 1760's the family was living somewhere on western frontier in an area frequented by the Shaunee Indians, for it was there that a very young son, 3 or 4 years old, was stolen by Indians, the Shaunee, between 1763 and 1765. He was adopted by Chief Pukeesheno, father of the famous Tecumseh, until they were defeated in October, 1774, at the battle of Point Pleasant, after which they were forced to give up their captives. Richard's family came to claim him but he didn't know them and didn't want to go with them. His mother recognized him by a birth mark. He retained many of his Indian habits for many years, but eventually joined the Army and rose to the rank of Colonel.

On this fourteenth day of January A. D. one thousand eight hundred and sixty four personally appeared before me Jessamine G W Traylor Clerk of the Circuit Court within and for the County and State of aforesaid Elizabeth Sparks a resident of Jennings Township in the County of Scott and State of Indiana aged twenty nine years, who being first duly sworn according to law, doth, on her oath, make the following declaration, in order to obtain the benefit of the provisions made by the act of Congress, approved July 14, 1862.

That she is the widow of William R. Sparks who enlisted in the service of United States at Scott County in the State of Indiana on or about the first day of August 1862 as a Private in Company K commanded by Captain Abraham H. Campbell in the Sixty Sixth Regiment of Indiana Volunteers in the War of 1861; who while in the service aforesaid and in the line of his duty died of lung fever at Colliersville in the State of Tennessee on the ninth day of October A. D. 1863.

She further declares that she was married to the said William R.
